Registration Procedure for 5768 Academic Year 2007-2008

Please complete and return the enclosed student registration form and course selection copy of the course grid with your course selections circled. We rely upon your prompt return of the completed forms to enable us to determine how many teachers to hire and how many classes we can offer. Note that there is a **\$40 savings** if registration forms are returned on or before July 31, 2007.

The course grid is a **draft**. There may be changes in course offerings and/or times courses are offered before the school year begins. Courses with low enrollments may be cancelled. Please register as soon as possible help avoid this situation and subsequent disappointment.

You may generally earn 3 credits per completed *annual* course at Delaware Gratz. Some one-semester courses carry different amounts of credit (usually 1.5). Gratz College JCHS will send you an Academic Bulletin for more information about End Goals and the number of credits necessary to reach them.

Service Learning Program classes are limited to a maximum enrollment of ten students on a first come/first serve basis. Students must register for all courses in the particular Program.

Please note that if there is an outstanding balance from prior years, registration for the upcoming year may not take place until all financial obligations are met.

When choosing your courses for next year, keep the following in mind:

1. Your **Hebrew level** is determined by our Hebrew Instructors. Hebrew class enrollment is determined by language ability, not by grade or age. At least one Hebrew course must be taken to qualify the distribution requirement for the end goals of the JCHS Teaching Certificate and for the JCHS Diploma.

2. Distribution requirements are required for both the JCHS Teaching Certificate and for the JCHS Diploma. The other Gratz end goals do not require these distribution requirements.

The **distribution requirements** are equal to at least one course in each of the following subject areas: Hebrew Language, Bible, Rabbinics (includes calendar, life cycle, tefillah, Talmud, etc), and History (includes Holocaust, Israel, general history). Candidates for the Teaching Certificate must also take Education 805*. These courses are offered at least once during the five year program.

3. Congregation Beth Shalom 7th and 8th grade students, preparing for their bar/bat mitzvah, who enroll in Prayer-based Hebrew and/or Finding Your Path to G-d will be eligible for a tuition discount for those two courses.

4. Students who are member of BBYO, NFTY or NCSY and enroll in Jewish Leaders: From Moses to Matisyahu will be eligible for a tuition discount on that course.

6. Earning 80 credits enables a student to be eligible to apply for the Greenbaum Scholarship.
