## Registration Procedure for 5770 Academic Year 2009-2010

Please complete and return the student registration form and course selection copy of the course grid with your course selections circled. We rely upon your prompt return of the completed forms to enable us to determine how many teachers to hire and how many classes we can offer. Note that there is a \$40 savings if registration forms are returned on or before July 15, 2009.

The course grid is a draft. There may be changes in course offerings and/or times courses are offered before the school year begins. Courses with low enrollments may be cancelled. Please register as soon as possible help avoid this situation and subsequent disappointment.

You may generally earn 3 credits per completed *annual* course at Delaware Gratz. Some one-semester courses carry different amounts of credit (usually 1.5).

Service Learning Program classes are limited to a maximum enrollment of ten to eleven students on a first come/first serve basis. Students must register for all courses in the particular Program.

Please note that if there is an outstanding balance from prior years, registration for the upcoming year may not take place until all financial obligations are met.

When choosing your courses for next year, keep the following in mind:

1. Your Hebrew level is determined by our Hebrew Instructor. Hebrew class enrollment is determined by language ability, not by grade or age.
2. 3. Congregation Beth Shalom 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, preparing for their bar/bat mitzvah, who enrolled in the Kehillah program will be eligible for a tuition discount.



Students who are member of BBYO, NFTY, USY or NCSY and enroll in the Wednesday night "What's Happening Now?" course will be eligible for a tuition discount on that course.

6. Earning 30 credits enables a student to be eligible to apply for the Greenbaum Scholarship from the Jewish Fund for the Future.
